Parking, Transportation Guide & Lodging-American University

We look forward to welcoming you to American University. Please use this guide to plan your trip and ensure a smooth arrival.

Parking Locations

Parking is available in two garages:

- School of International Service (SIS) Garage enter from Nebraska Ave. (Map & Directions PDF)
- Katzen Arts Center Garage enter from Nebraska or Massachusetts Ave. (Visitor Info)

Both garages are a short walk to the <u>Mary Graydon Student Center (MGSC)</u>, where Institute sessions take place.

Rates & Payment

- \$2/hour or \$16/day
- Pay at stations located in garage elevator lobbies

Metro, Bus & Shuttle

- Metro: Closest stop is <u>Tenleytown-AU</u> (Red Line).
- From Metro: Take the <u>AU Shuttle</u> (Blue Route/Red Express) from 40th St. NW &
 Albemarle St. NW, in front of Whole Foods. <u>Shuttle Schedules</u> can be found on this
 page.
- **Bus**: Metrobus lines serving AU include C81, D90, and D96.

Motorcycles & Scooters

- Motorcycles: Park in a valid space; pay by permit or Pay-As-You-Go.
- Motorized scooters (50–250cc): No permit required but must park in designated motorcycle zones (marked with signage and red-painted boxes).

Please park only in AU garages with valid payment. Do **not** park on neighborhood streets. This ensures AU remains a good community partner under city agreements.

Hotels and Lodging

American University has negotiated discounted rates with several area hotels located conveniently to the campus. Reservations for travel can be booked directly with the hotel via the <u>Campus Travel Management portal</u>. A small percentage of the proceeds from reservations made here will be returned to AU to support university programs and initiatives.

Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations

American University supports sustainable transportation and carbon neutrality by providing **19 Level 2 EV charging stations** across campus. These stations add approximately **25 miles of range per hour**. Charging at standard outlets by non-AU vehicles is prohibited.
